## How to Measure Your Child's Feet



Print our Shoe Sizing Chart at 100\%. (Make sure your printer's Page Scaling option is set to "None".)


To ensure your printout is accurate, measure the printed ruler with a real ruler. The printer ruler should be exactly 8 " long.

Ask your child to stand against a wall, in a room with hard flooring (not carpet).


Position the printout under one of your child's feet, making sure your child's weight is evenly distributed. Line your child's heel up with the heel of your printout and measure.


Then measure the other foot the same way. If the sizes differ, order the larger shoe size.
