1 Slice a large potato in half, then use a small knife to cut out a circle on one cut side of the potato. (A round cookie cutter also works well for this.) Trim away excess

potato so that you are left with a raised circle shape.

2 Blot away any moisture with a paper towel.



3 Apply acrylic paint (such as FolkArt Acrylic Paint, \$1.99 at JoAnn.com) to potato.

4 Stamp polka dot designs on furniture or cute cardboard suitcases (such as Cool Euro Suitcases, set of 3, \$32 at TheCargoStore.com).
